Mary Lee White-Jackson, 98, transitioned from life on Thursday, December 21, 2023, at her home in Lexington, MS. she was born to the late James White Sr. and Martha Jane Freedom White on April 15, 1925, in Holmes County; she was the first child of James and Martha White.
