Tennessee, Florida, and Oklahoma. Even after being diagnosed with renal failure, Pat's adventurous spirit didn't falter. She enjoyed meeting new doctors, nurses, and patients at the many dialysis facilities she visited, often bringing her trademark cheer and positivity to those around her.

Pat was preceded in death by her parents; her grandmother, Rosie Bell Guyton; her sisters, Diane Guyton and Brenda Quinn; her eldest son, Damien Maurice Tucker; her stepson, Curtis Baldwin Jr.; and a host of other loving relatives.
